- support planning and feasibility studies for innovative technology demonstrations including technical and economic feasibility

- carry out the majority of the work in the UK for green corridor projects
- intend to exploit the results from or in the UK

Competition closes at 11:00am on 13 July 2022
Your project can start by 1 January 2023
Future CMDC Rounds, later in 2022, will fund projects that have longer durations as part of the multi year programme.
