UK-EU Trade and Cooperation Agreement

Fundamentals

- Deal better than No-deal
 - But deal is limited
- No introduction of Tariffs and/or Quotas welcomed
- Continue liberal principle of International Maritime Services
 - Create framework for future dialogue

No effect on changes introduced as of 1 January 2021

- Uses World Custom Organisation language and ideals
- Trade Specialised Committee on Customs Cooperation and Rules of Origin
 - Two Single Windows?
- Loss of Authorised Regular Shipping Service status
- Requirement for haulage permits in EU removed

Passengers

Limited provision

- Visa-Free travel
 - No other special treatment for respective nationals
- No equivalent maritime consideration of aviation PNR and API
 - Duty-free not covered

Onto 2021

- Encourage better engagement and transparency in TSC
- Encourage progress on UK Future Borders and Future Freight programme
 - Monitor risks to Level Playing Field
 - Monitor market developments
 - How will Freeports effect freight?
